Introduction

At Dulwich Prep London we have a vibrant and exciting extended day provision designed to support working parents requiring flexibility outside school hours. Once boys and girls have completed their after school clubs or prep sessions, they are able to seamlessly transfer to our extended day provision @38.

With this provision taking place on school grounds, they are immediately at ease and comfortable in familiar surroundings full of familiar faces.

We run a fully managed programme which is overseen by our full-time teaching staff play leaders, who ensure that children are well cared for and engaged in fun activities whilst on site.

Dulwich Prep @38 aims to provide that “home from home” feeling. Rainbow Club, which runs before and after school on our Early Years site, becomes part of our @38 provision after 17.00 on our Alleyn Park Site.

@38 offers prep time alongside an array of organised activities: multisport options, puzzles and board games, creative and craft sessions as well as free play. All of the activities are tailored to meet the needs of the specific age groups, making use of the fabulous facilities on our Alleyn Park site. Spaces such as the library, sports hall, playgrounds and quiet areas will all be used to provide the children with exciting, stimulating and relaxing activities, depending on their preference.

The provision for children from Nursery to Year 2 will start at the end of their normal school day and run until 18.30, including tea. For boys from Year 3 to Year 8, @38 will start at once they have finished their paid or unpaid after school clubs and activities or been to prep class. This can run until 19:30 for boys from Year 3 to 8.

Parents are able to book a single session or multiple combinations of the extended day provision based on their daily needs. This can be done through the Parent Portal on our school website.

Useful information

Before School

Children will be welcomed on site from 07.00 for breakfast and supervision. The children will need to arrive between 07.00 - 07.45. They will be provided with breakfast and supervised until 8.00, then they will be sent / escorted to their relevant sections.

Parents of Pre-Prep children can take their sons to the 08.00 Early Drop Off. The drop off is at the lower Bowen Drive Gate between 08.00 and 08.15. There is no charge for this provision and no need to book this.

After School - until 17.00

After School Care in Pre-Prep starts at 15.45. There is a 15.45 - 16.30 slot and a 15.45 - 17.00 slot. There is one flat fee for this session. When booking Year 1 and 2 After School Care, please ensure that you select the correct booking slot. Your son will be brought to the Lower Bowen Drive pick up point at either 16.30 or 17.00 depending on the slot booked. The staff in Pre-Prep will try where possible to assist with homework but they are unable to listen to all the boys read individually for 10/15 minutes. Instead, the boys will be directed to a fun, engaging activity, as appropriate.

Prep classes will be available for boys from Year 3 to 8 from 15.45 till 17.00. Boys will be able to complete their independent reading and assigned prep tasks. In any remaining time the boys will be directed to an engaging activity.

After School - post 17.00

For boys staying onsite from 17.00 'tea' will be provided. After tea boys will be engaged in activities until they are collected. Children from Nursery to Year 2 must be collected by 18.30. Boys from Year 3 to 8 must be collected by 19.30.
